

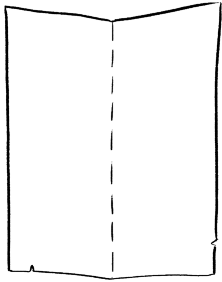
HOW TO MAKE A ZOOMER BOOMER 3000

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Sheet of A4 paper
- Sticky tape
- Coloured pencils

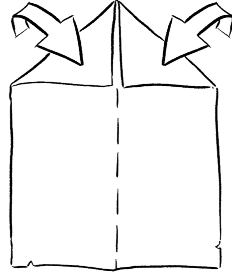
BILLY TIP:

Before making the Zoomer Boomer 3000 check to see that your smile is big. You can test this in the mirror.



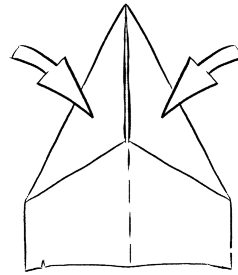
STEP 1:

Fold the paper in half vertically, and then unfold.



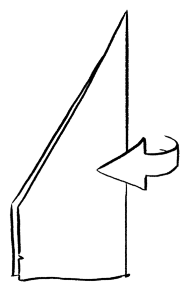
STEP 2:

Fold down each of the top corners into the centre line.



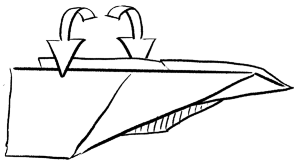
STEP 3:

Fold the top edges to meet in the centre. Then draw a picture of the moon on the back and colour it in.



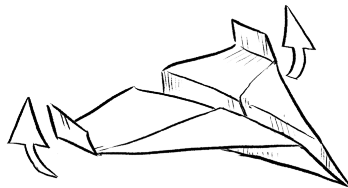
STEP 4:

Fold the paper in half, with the flaps on the inside.



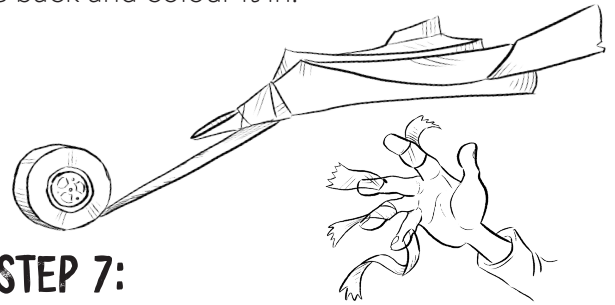
STEP 5:

Fold the first wing down. Then fold the other wing down. Try to make sure the wings are equal.



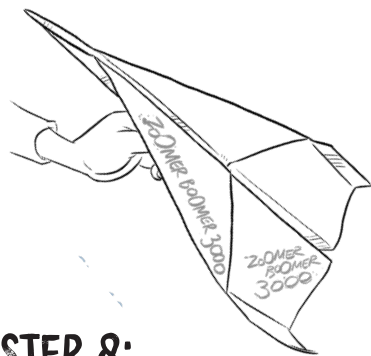
STEP 6:

Fold the bottom of both wings up by about one centimetre.



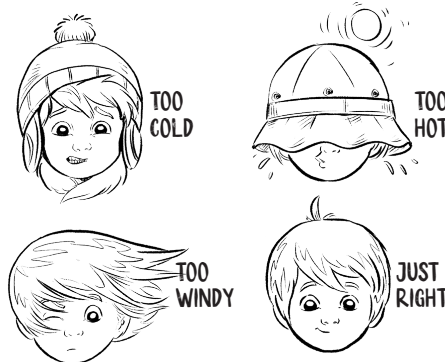
STEP 7:

Add sticky tape to the nose of the plane. This keeps the wings from separating in flight. Be careful not to use too much sticky tape as it can sometimes get stuck all over your fingers.



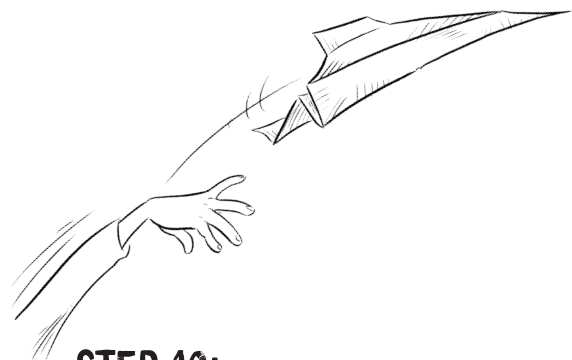
STEP 8:

Write *Zoomer Boomer 3000* on your plane how ever you want! Your Zoomer Boomer is finished.



STEP 9:

Find a safe, open space outside. Make sure the flying conditions are perfect.



STEP 10:

Gently, but firmly, throw your Zoomer Boomer 3000 towards the sky.
