Book Review Sunflower

Supplies*:

- White paper plate
- Brown paint
- Black paint or black crepe paper
- Paintbrush
- PVA glue
- Yellow coloured paper
- Orange coloured paper
- Petal template (printed from page 2 of these instructions)
- Green cardboard
- Masking tape
- Book review leaf template (printed from page 3 of these instructions)
- Blu-Tack.

Directions:

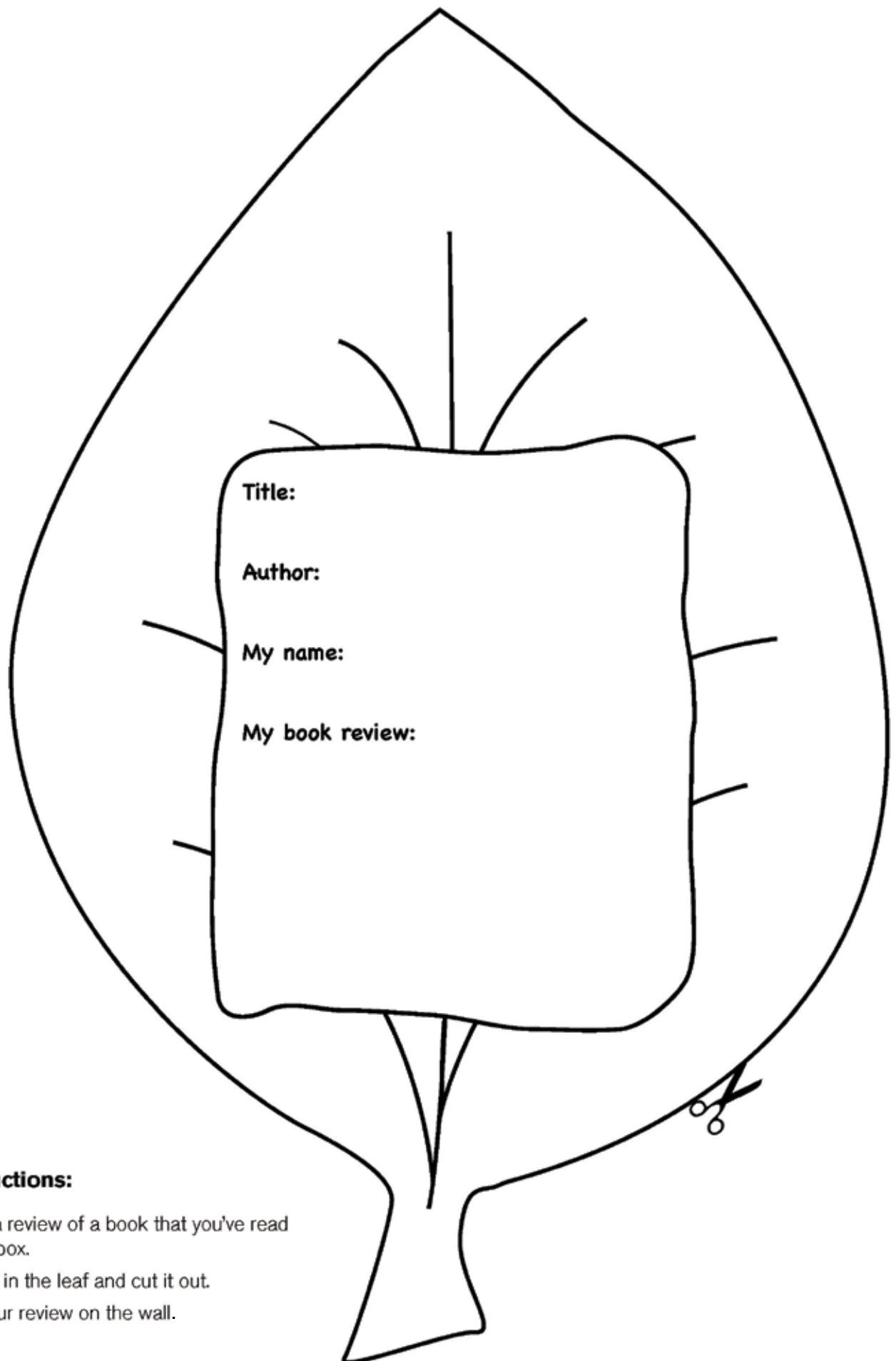
1. Paint the paper plate brown and allow to dry.
2. Paint black dots onto the paper plate (or roll black crepe paper into tiny seeds and glue onto the centre of the plate).
3. Use the petal template to print approximately 7 A4 sheets of yellow petals and 7 A4 sheets of orange petals.
4. Use PVA glue to stick the petals to the outside edge of the paper plate, alternate and layer the two colours.
5. Cut a tall stem from green cardboard and fasten to a wall where you will display your giant sunflower. Use double-sided masking tape to fasten the sunflower to the top of the stem.
6. Print off many book review leaves from the template on page 3 and leave near your sunflower with some Blu-Tack for students and staff to easily fasten to the stem of the sunflower.



*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use whatever supplies you have on-hand for substitutions.







Instructions:

1. Write a review of a book that you've read in the box.
2. Colour in the leaf and cut it out.
3. Put your review on the wall.
