

## COVID-19 LOCKDOWN – ONLINE READINGS – SCHOOLS AND LIBRARIES

Last updated 20 July 2021

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1. Teachers and educators may post videos of themselves reading a Scholastic Australia title and post it within a closed educational platform such as Google Classroom, Seesaw, Class Dojo and other services. If a Teacher or Educator plans to share a story time video by recording a video, uploading it to a YouTube channel, and posting a link to that YouTube video inside a closed educational platform, that YouTube video must be designated as “Unlisted” (not “Public”) when uploading.
2. Please ensure that you delete any recordings created upon the date in which your school reopens to your students and ordinary in-class learning resumes, **no later than 31 August 2021**.
3. Before posting each video, please email [permissions@scholastic.com.au](mailto:permissions@scholastic.com.au) with the details of the book you wish to record. In this regard, please make sure to list out each title, as well as the relevant author and illustrator. We will respond to confirm that Scholastic Australia publishes the work, holds the relevant rights to grant permission under this policy and that the delivery form you have chosen is compliant. Please refrain from publishing your recording until you have received permission.
4. At the beginning of your reading, please ensure that you credit all creators (author/s and illustrator/s) and state that you are presenting your reading “...with permission from Scholastic Australia”.

## For Libraries

1. To replace local storytime events, libraries may host real-time, storytime events on Zoom.
2. These storytime or read-aloud live events may not be recorded or retained after the event has concluded. **Please note that permission to pre-record and store readings does not apply to libraries, only to educators on closed-platforms.**
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
