- Before reading the story, as a class look closely at the cover and title, and discuss what you can learn about the book from the artwork, and from the name of the story. Some things that you might like to include in your discussion could be:
 - o What can you see happening on the front cover of the book?
 - o What is the title of the story?o What do you think a family tree is?
 - What can you see happening in the background of the cover artwork?
 - o Can you identify the types of trees and plants shown on the cover? Where are these trees native to?
 - o Where do you think that this story might be set, and what about the cover artwork makes you think this?
- In the story, the tree says that its 'roots dug deep'. Why is it important for a tree's roots to be deep?
 - What do we mean when we use this expression figuratively to talk of people having roots dug deep?

- What other phrases or expressions can you find in the story that are literally true when referring to the tree, but can also be interpreted figuratively when talking about people?
- Where do you think the girl in the story travels to when she leaves the family tree and her home? Why do you think this? What clues can you see in the illustrations that tell us where she has gone?
- How does reading this story make you feel?
 - o What different emotions did you feel at different parts of the story and why do you think you felt them/what in the book triggered them?
 - o Create an artwork that shares your emotive response to this story, or to part of this story. Caption your artwork with a quote from the book, or with what you feel is the most important message of the story overall.

- What Australian native animals appear in this book?
- In the story, the tree says 'My own seeds too, caught the wind to fly from my boughs, and dance upon the air.
 To settle in lands I wouldn't see and couldn't know'
 - o What countries have eucalyptus trees been taken to and then planted in?
 - o Research this online or in the school library and write a brief history of eucalyptus plantings in foreign countries.
- What are we usually referring to when we talk about a family tree?
 On an A4 piece of paper draw the outline of a tree, and then turn it into your family tree by drawing small labelled pictures of yourself and your family members on the branches, trunk and leaves.
- Choose one of the people shown in the story and write a short story from their point of view featuring the family tree.

BEFORE READING

- Before reading Eyes That Speak to the Stars, view the cover and title of the book. Identify the following:
 - o The title of the book
 - o The author/illustrator
 - o The publisher
 - o The blurb
- Based on the cover, what do you think this story is about? Why? Did your opinion change after reading the blurb? Revisit this discussion once you have read the book and see if your ideas about what the story was about were correct.
- What sort of story do you think this
 is going to be? Happy? Sad? Funny?
 Why do think this story is going to be
 happy/sad/funny? Was it the cover,
 blurb or something else that made
 you think this?

AFTER READING


- In the beginning of the story, a troubling event occurs; this is called a microagression. What happens? Why do you think this microaggression is so hurtful to the young boy?
- Who is Baba and how does he comfort the young boy? What do Baba's eyes tell the young boy? What do you think the young boy learns about himself through his relationships with Baba?
- We often resemble people in our families. Who are you most like in your family? How are you most like them? Who makes you feel like you can 'soar above the clouds' and in what ways?
- Why is it significant that Baba's eyes resemble someone else's in the young boy's family? What is this individual's relationship to the young boy?

- What stories do Agong's eyes tell the young boy? What do you think it means when Agong looks at the young boy like he's 'the only answer that matters'? What does the young boy learn about himself through his relationship with Agong?
- The young boy goes for early morning walks with his Agong. What are some everyday rituals you do with a member of your family? Who do you share the special time with? Why do you enjoy this special activity?
- Whose eyes do Agong's look like?
 Describe this person's relationship
 to the young boy. How do you know?
 How does this person impact the
 main character?
- The boy in the story has a moment of heartbreak in the beginning of the story. He also mentions that his eyes and those of his loved ones allow him to realise that he can 'break through dark and doubt'. What do you think this means? Have you had moments where you had doubt? What did you do and how did you overcome it?
- What are some 'impossibilities' that you dream about? What dreams are nurtured by the people in your family? What hopes do you have for the future? How does your family help you to dream big and be 'visionary'?
- The illustrator captures the wonder and love the young boy has for his family. Looking at the beautiful illustrations by Dung Ho, which are your favourite? Why? What strengths do her illustrations bring to the young boy?

ACTIVITIES

 The young boy's eyes 'spoke to the stars'. Sometimes people make wishes

- on stars. Cut out some stars and write some of your wishes on them. Hang your stars on a coathanger or sticks to create a mobile that you can hang in your room.
- The young boy's Agong has the perspective of his ancestors and can 'gaze into the distance'. Interview a member of your family who is much older than you. Create a list of questions to ask about their life as a child and the lives of their parents before them. What was it like for them growing up? What parts of history can be shared from their perspective? What lessons can you learn from their 'gaze'?
- Everyone has treasures inside that unfold when our loved ones remind us that we have them. What is your superpower? How are you strong? What are the ways you 'soar into the clouds' with your natural talents? Create a superhero costume highlighting your superpower. Draw, build or sew your design and explain to the class how your design choices showcase your strengths.
- Grab a flashlight and create a fort! The young boy in the story has a playful relationship with Di-Di, his younger brother. They share a loving bond, full of joy and laughter. Do you have a younger sibling, cousin or neighbour who you can shine a flashlight together with? Who is it? What are ways you can encourage them and show them they are special too? With permission from a parent, ask if you can share your flashlight with them under the fort. Perhaps, you can even share a snack together!
