

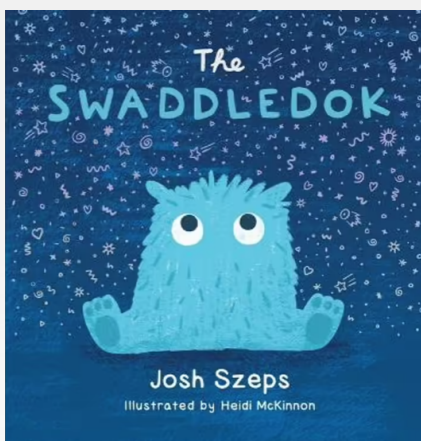

Josh is the host of Afternoons with Josh Szeps on ABC Radio Sydney and the former co-anchor of Weekend Breakfast on ABC TV.

After spending his uni years doing satirical comedy sketches on Mike Carlton's radio show, Josh moved to New York to host an irreverent weekly television show on Discovery Science Channel. Quickly, CBS News Productions picked him up to anchor its Peabody Award-winning U.S. television show, Channel One News.

What put Josh on the international map was founding and presenting HuffPost Live, the multi-award winning American talk network that revolutionised how celebrities and viewers interact.

He hosted over a thousand hours of live television and attracted billions of views thanks to his entertaining and insightful interviews with Hollywood A-listers and global leaders.

During his time at the Huffington Post, Josh won a Webby Award and the Huffington Post won a Pulitzer.

Josh's sharp wit scored him a regular spot with Al Roker on the NBC TODAY Show with its audience of 40 million. He is also a seven-time guest on the world's most popular podcast, the Joe Rogan Experience.

At venues around the world, Josh interviews the likes of Richard Dawkins, Fran Lebowitz, Peter Singer, Jonathan Haidt and Jane Goodall.

Josh was crowned the Best Host in Australia by the Radio Today Awards for his podcast, Uncomfortable Conversations, the pre-eminent place for newsmakers, entertainers and thinkers to explore dangerous ideas. The show is available as a free audio show, or as a Substack subscription with exclusive content.
